Welcome to Fan Crafting with Sporticulture™

Let's get started on you Team Pride Diamond Painting Craft Kit:

- 1. Unroll the Diamond Painting Canvas.
- 2. Peel back the protective film from the first area to be worked on.
 Tip: Do not remove the protective film from the whole design.
 Gradually peel back the film as you progress.
- 3. The charted area is pre-printed with a special adhesive.
 Tip: Be sure to re-cover the adhesive area with the protective film when you are not working on the canvas. This saves the adhesive surface from drying out or collecting dust.
- 4. Identify the first symbol on the chart to be worked.
- Locate the symbol and its diamond painting gem number on the key at the side of the design. The gem number is to the right of the symbol.
- 6. Identify the gem number on the pre-sorted diamond painting gem packets. Each packet is labelled with a serial number, diamond painting gem number, and custom shade code. Be sure the gem number corresponds to the symbol on the key.
- 7. Pour the diamond painting gems into the tray provided.
- Open the wax caddy. The caddy includes two circular disks of wax. Start with the top disk by peeling away the clear film from the surface.
- Slide the grip cover onto the stylus for a better grasp and control of the tool.
- **10.** Press the head of the stylus firmly into the wax several times before picking up the first gem.

Tip: It is important to coat/load the head of the stylus very well with wax before picking up the first gem. You may also move the head of the stylus from side to side in the wax at first to ensure a good coating. Once a good coating is achieved, you will not need to dip into the wax so often.

11. Pick up the gem from the tray making sure to place the head of the stylus over the round/faceted side.

Tip: Gently shaking the try can help flip the gems so the round/ faceted side is facing up. Use the flat tool on the top of the stylus for multi gem pick-up.

12. Place the gem onto the corresponding symbol on the chart. The adhesive surface on the chart makes it easy to place and stick the flat side of the gem down. Continue the process working one shade at a time.

Tip: We recommend starting at the bottom edge of the design working your way up. Gems can be re-positioned after sticking; however, it is not recommended and may compromise the integrity of the surface.

- 13. When you are not working on the project, place the protective film back over the canvas to protect the design from drying out or collecting dust.
- 14. Be sure to also close or re-cover the wax to stop it from drying out.
- 15. Wrap the head of your stylus in plastic when not in use to prevent it from drying out.
- 16. Store unused gems in the plastic bags provided. Be sure to label your bag with the corresponding key symbol or number.

Care Instruction:

If the fabric becomes soiled during the working process it can be cleaned by gently wiping (avoid scrubbing) with a soft damp cloth. (Use cold water)

When your design is complete, lay the protective film over the top of the diamond area and using a cylindrical container like a glass bottle or rolling pin, gently roll over to secure the diamond gems on the sticky surface.

Warning:

Keep away from ink pens and paints. Do not wash, iron or dry clean. Ages 13 and up.
